League, Simon Parsons reports on where it all began for the young Princess Elizabeth and her admiration for the Pembroke Welsh Corgi, including a family tree revealing where the Windsor line started from. We include a selection of images taken from the archives that include The Queen visiting The Kennel Club at Clarges Street on its centenary year in 1973 and the time she visited Crufts on 9 February 1969.

Crufts looks forward to hosting the many amazing competitions that makes the show the canine celebration that it is, such as The Kennel Club Hero Dog award and of course the ultimate Best in Show, but it is also excited to welcome back, for the first time since 2020, the Junior Warrant final on Thursday and the International Junior Handling competition which we are proud to announce will be renamed The Joe Cartledge Memorial International Junior Handling competition and will take place on Friday. The following competitions will be scheduled in the Resorts World Arena with a full programme being released very soon.

This will be a one off competition in order to mark The Kennel Club's 150th anniversary and will take place on Thursday 9 March and see the Best in Show winners from the All Breed Championship Dog shows that took place in 2022 invited to take part. With many of the popular events back on the programme and the new one off competition celebrating The Kennel Club's 150th anniversary, we look forward to it being one of the best shows yet, celebrating our dog heroes and what they have meant to us over the last few years."

New also for this year the Bavarian Mountain Hound will have their own class, and as has taken place over the last few years special permission has been given to Crufts for the award of Reserve Best in Show to be given out immediately prior to the award of Best in Show.

This year the breed competitions are scheduled to take place on the following days:

- Thursday, 9 March 2023 - Gundog
- Friday, 10 March 2023 - Working and Pastoral
- Saturday, 11 March 2023 - Terrier and Hound
- Sunday, 12 March 2023 - Utility and Toy

Crufts schedules and entries will be open online from the 14 November with admission tickets going on sale on the same day. Entry fees and admission tickets prices will remain unchanged from the 2022 show.

The Kennel Club launches new DNA Testing Services

The Kennel Club is launching its new DNA Testing Services, developed to improve and protect dog health via genetic research, and to promote responsible dog breeding.

The Kennel Club DNA Testing Services has been uniquely established to advance understanding of dog genetics and disease, and to improve the health of dogs now and in the future, with those who use the service contributing to canine genetic research both through data collection and with all funds reinvested into ongoing research.

Via a simple cheek swab, the service checks a dog's DNA for markers associated with a number of different inherited disorders and provides condition and/or breed-specific advice to help breeders to reduce the risk of producing puppies affected by inherited conditions, so they can ultimately be eradicated through responsible breeding. Whilst providing breeders

peace of mind that puppies were produced with utmost diligence, test results will automatically be registered on a dog's record and be freely available on The Kennel Club website, allowing puppy buyers to check if the dog they are thinking of buying has come from health-tested parents.

Aimed at anyone considering breeding from their dog and available for 80 breeds, The Kennel Club DNA Testing Services will launch in November, with an introductory £20 off for all breed specific packages with DNA profiling included. The Kennel Club's geneticist, Dr Joanna Ilska, is hosting an interactive webinar on 3 November at 19:00pm about all things DNA testing - more information will be available at thekennelclub.org.uk/health

The Kennel Club urges awareness of current import regulations following additional extension

Following a further extension to the current ban in place for the commercial imports of dogs, cats and ferrets from Belarus, Poland, Romania and Ukraine, The Kennel Club is reminding dog breeders and owners to ensure they are aware of the ban and to thoroughly review the rules in place.

The Kennel Club recently alerted breeders and owners to the temporary suspension in Great Britain, which was implemented in April 2022 and had initially been extended until 3 September. However, the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs (DEFRA) has since announced that this measure has been extended by a further eight weeks, until 29 October, owing to a reported health risk to humans and animals from commercial cats, dogs and ferrets from these countries that do not comply with UK health and documentation requirements. The importation of dogs for rescue and rehoming purposes is also covered under this prohibition.

Dr Ed Hayes, Head of Public Affairs at The Kennel Club comments: "The movement of dogs under the Pet Travel Scheme from Belarus, Poland and Romania remains permitted, with special measures in place for bringing pets from Ukraine. We would urge anyone seeking to bring dogs into the UK from these four countries to carefully check the rules to ensure that any movement complies, particularly in light of this additional extension.

"Furthermore, we would also implore anyone with considering importing dogs from these countries in the short to medium term to carry out due diligence in the event that the ban is extended further. Any dogs which have been imported in breach of Government regulations will not be registered by The Kennel Club."

Discover DOGS

Thousands of visitors enjoyed Discover Dogs on 15 and 16 October.

Taking place at ExCeL in London, we saw the return of exciting canine activities, clever training displays, the ever-popular Cuddle Corner and hundreds of breed booths. Dog enthusiasts, prospective owners and those already with canine companions spent the two-day event speaking to experts, learning about how to choose the right dog for their lifestyle, enjoying training demonstrations and watching a variety of canine competitions, including agility and flyball.

In a celebration of everything dogs can do, Discover Dogs packed in displays, demonstrations and competitions across three different rings. This year saw the debut of the 'Woofball World Cup', where a crowd of football fanatic fans gathered to see a highly anticipated match of Barkalona vs. West Hound Utd. Impressive displays from the smart sniffing Medical Detection Dogs, courageous West Midlands Police dogs, and the synchronized Staffordshire Bull Terrier and Golden Retriever Display teams were memorable for onlookers.

Elsewhere, the weekend saw the semi-finals of the Novice ABC agility competitions, Young Kennel Club Handling, and Scruffts heats, the nation's favourite cross-breed competition sponsored by James Wellbeloved, which gave some lucky dogs and their owners a spot in the semi-finals taking place at



Crufts, the world's greatest dog show, in March 2023.

Top training tips were demonstrated by dog behavioralists, experts, and representatives of The Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog scheme, to help owners with basic skills for everyday life and understand more about competitions like Obedience and Obreedience they can try with the four-legged friend.

While Kids Zone and the Young Kennel Club ring kept younger members of the family entertained, away from the rings shopping stands supplied a variety of goods for taking home souvenirs, as well as areas for visitors to learn more about different welfare organisations, including The Kennel Club Charitable Trust and Kennel Club Breed Rescue.

Vanessa McAlpine, Events Executive at The Kennel Club, who's last Discover Dogs this will be further to her retirement next year said: "We are delighted to have welcomed so many dog-loving visitors to London this weekend for another successful event.

for the Agility World Championships in 2028, during such a historic year for the discipline.

As October draws to a dark and windy close, we at the Kennel Club, are in full swing of our Autumn Member engagement roadshows, having spoken to over 150 members across Stockport, Bexleyheath, Taunton and at The Kennel Club Building in Stoneleigh. We've also engaged with over 100 of our members via virtual meetings. Thank you to everyone so far who has come out to meet us face-to-face or on-line.

It's been heartening to hear the words of support as we have shared the newly approved strategic direction. And this has in turn led to some really good discussions, conversations and interactions. We've been gathering feedback on the strategy, but also on the events themselves and this will help us to better understand what members value and how they would like us to continue talking and meeting with them as we go forward.

By now, many of our members will know that at these roadshows we have launched our new Purpose – ***Making a positive difference for dogs and their owners.*** An evolution of our current mission – bringing in the positive aspects of what we stand for and want to deliver, importantly including the wonderful relationship that owners have with their dogs, but also remembering our heritage.

Supporting this purpose the Kennel Club Board have approved 6 strategic aims:

Underpinning these strategic aims are a number of enablers. These outline the big changes we will need to make so that we can start to move towards delivering our strategic aims.

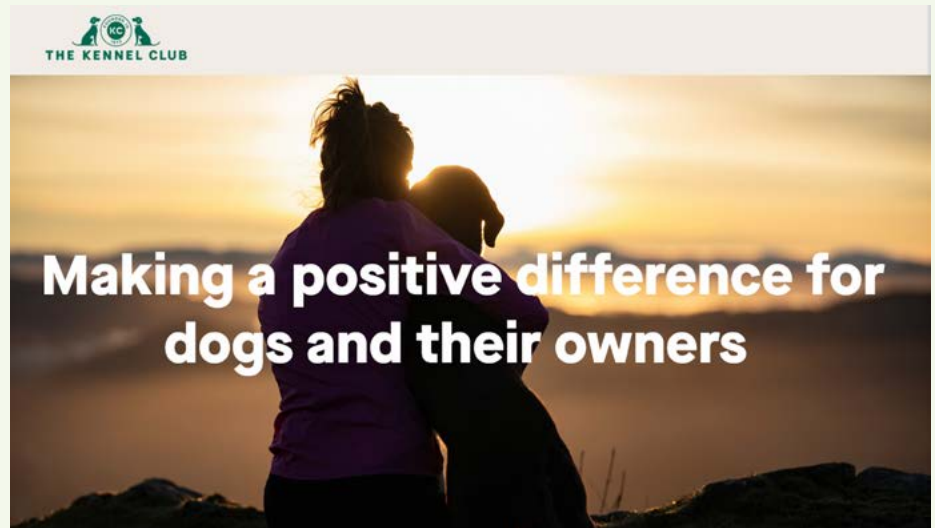
And discussing these is what our roadshow programme has been all about.

Clearly, we can't do everything all at once, so we're taking a phased approach to delivering our aims and strategic enablers. Not only are there many links and dependencies between them but also there are some critical activities that we need to progress before we can start others. During November the Board will be deciding and agreeing the sequence in which we will tackle these changes and our plan for implementation in 2023, and we'll be sharing these with you in next month's journal.

Discussing them with members and hearing their views has been extremely helpful. We've heard what they like, we've heard what they would like to know more about and of course, we have listened to their concerns.

We hear that they are supportive of the strategic direction and the strategic aims. That they appreciate us sharing and discussing it with them, hearing their voice. And they are fully supportive of more and better two way communication between members and the Kennel Club in the future.

Of course, a couple of key concerns have also come through; Firstly that we need to address our systems issues, secondly the impact that the cost of living will have on our dog communities and thirdly needing to be better at



communicating with all our stakeholders, members, our grass roots and by that we mean local clubs, training clubs and volunteers.

Work is already underway to assess our options around improving our CRM system and processes and using our inhouse digital team to maintain and improve where we can. It's clearly one of our early priorities.

Our grassroots network and local dog communities are the foundation of everything the Kennel Club does and we recognise that we need a better and stronger relationship with them. For the sport, for dogs and

their owners, and for the future. That's why we've commissioned some new research into understanding the unmet needs, attitudes, and behaviours of people who take part in dog

activities, including showing, field trials, obedience, agility and all other activities people can participate in with their dogs. We'll be talking to those who compete, as well as those who organise and run these events and activities at every

level across the UK. 2022 will be the first year with no

restrictions since 2019 and so this autumn feels like a good time to look back and reflect on what is different and how the needs and wants of participants and organisers may have changed because of the pandemic and the current cost of living crisis.

We still have two more roadshows this year – one in Bridgend in Wales (24 November) and another in Glasgow (29 November), so there is still time for members to sign up via the link in the last email we sent on or on the Members Zone on the website. In December, once these last roadshows have been completed, we will start sharing our strategic direction more widely across the dog community and the general public. We look forward to sharing more with you then.

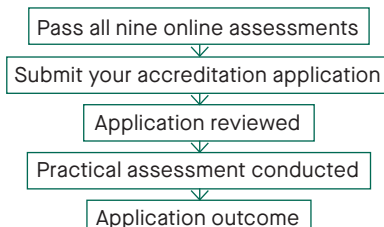

BREED STANDARD AMENDMENT

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendment to the colour clause of the Dachshund Breed Standard. As a result, the lists of colours available for registration have been amended across all six varieties, and these are now available during the registration process.

DACHSHUND

Colour The following colours are permitted in all six varieties:

- Red – which may be interspersed with black hairs.
- Black or Chocolate – each with tan markings (as clear as possible) over eyes, on sides of muzzle, under jaw and down chest, on lower part of legs and feet, below the tail and about one third of underside of tail.
- Dapple pattern – (lighter coloured areas on a darker base, where neither the light nor the dark colour should predominate) is permitted in any of the colours listed as acceptable, with the exception of brindle.

The following colours are acceptable only in the varieties specified:

Miniature Smooth-haired and Miniature Long-haired:

- Cream (fawn), interspersed black hairs are permissible.
- Black/chocolate and cream – where the cream is as clear as possible and is distributed in the same locations as the tan marking listed above.

Smooth-haired, Miniature Smooth-haired and Miniature Long-haired:

- Brindle – black hairs forming stripes on any of the colours listed above.

Wire-haired and Miniature Wire-haired:

- Wild Boar of any shade, or Chocolate Wild Boar with tan markings as clear as possible in the same locations as the tan markings listed above

Nose and nails black in all colours except chocolate/tan and chocolate dapple where they are brown.

In all colours no white permissible, save for a small patch on chest which is permitted but not desirable.

Double Dapple (where varying amounts of white occur all over the body in addition to the dapple pattern) is unacceptable.

Dilute colours isabella and blue are unacceptable.

All other colours or patterns including piebald and tricolour are highly undesirable.
