Her Majesty The Queen

The Queen was a world famous dog lover, especially known for her Welsh Pembroke Corgis after being gifted her first Corgi, Susan by her father, King George VI when she was eighteen. This was to be the start of nearly 80 years of Corgis in the royal household that would accompany her on many trips and be by her side through her long reigning monarchy. The Queen stopped breeding in 2015 and got her last two puppies in 2021.

The Queen was claimed to have an interest in Crufts and visited the show in 1969 where she was shown around the show and met an English Springer Spaniel.

Tony Allcock OBE, Chairman of The Kennel Club, said: "We pass on our thoughts and condolences to His Majesty The King and the Royal family at this time and join the world in sorrow at her passing.

"The Queen was an avid dog lover. She was very interested in the health of Corgis and took the breeding of her dogs very seriously, always ensuring that she met with the dogs involved.

"The Queen also owned Spaniels and was familiar to members and staff at The Kennel Club for her involvement in Field Trials, often attending events when taking place on her estate in Sandringham, where she was always extremely friendly to the dogs and competitors alike.

"We are very grateful for The Queen's patronage over the years and the commitment she always showed to the dogs that she loved so dearly. The Queen epitomised the love and affection that our nation holds for dogs."



Junior Warrant points criteria expanded

The Kennel Club Board has agreed to expand the points criteria under which Junior Warrant points can be claimed, with immediate effect.

In the case of open shows, in addition to those wins which currently qualify for one point, the following also now meet the criteria: any group placing, any puppy group placing, Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show or Reserve Best Puppy in Show where at least one other dog was competing. This will only be valid if no other Junior Warrant points have been claimed for this dog at the show.

The criteria for championship shows has also been updated so as to make it possible to claim points for both Best of Sex and Best Puppy of Sex wins.

Only one point may be claimed from any open show and this clause remains unchanged. There is also no change to the championship show points criteria.

Kathryn Mansfield, Kennel Club Secretary, said: "We are very pleased to announce these amendments to the points system for the Junior

Warrant title. Open shows are a very important 'training ground' in the UK for young dogs and so it is only right that the top awards at group and Best in Show level should count toward this award.

"In the case of championship shows, under the previous points system, dogs which had won a breed class and were unable to claim points (i.e. only one in the class) and were subsequently awarded Best of Sex (beating the correct number of dogs) or Best Puppy of Sex were still unable to claim any points unless they went on to win Best of Breed. This latest update remedies that situation."

The October issue of the Kennel Gazette pays tribute to Her Majesty The Queen and her role as The Kennel Club's Patron of 70 years. The Queen was a world-famous dog lover and grew up with dogs – her iconic Pembroke Welsh Corgis have been in her life since she was seven years old. She is also a well-regarded breeder of working Gundogs, particularly Labrador Retrievers and Cocker Spaniels, bred and trained as working dogs for the Sandringham, Balmoral and Windsor shoots. Our November Kennel Gazette will be a special tribute to Her Majesty The Queen and her life in dogs.

Other special features include a look at scentwork and the psychological and emotional satisfaction it can have on both dogs and their owners. We talk to co-founder of UK Sniffer Dogs Jamie Pound who featured on TV during Crufts 2022 presenting demonstrations on his reward-based training methods. Championship show judge, dog handler, dog trainer and TV presenter, Marina White discovers a new activity: paddleboarding with her Dalmatian, Coco, and explains why she decided to enter the Dog Surfing Championships. Ambassador to The Kennel Club Charitable Trust, Nathalie Knauf, shares her story of a shocking childhood incident that inspired her to support the welfare of dogs in the UK and how she has helped support the Trust's Appeal for Ukraine. Nathalie talks about her first Crufts and how her Pomeranian, Misty, quickly made the headlines. Lastly, we congratulate the championship final winners from this year's International Agility Festival who instructed their dogs around a course that tested handling

strategy and their dogs' independent skills on the obstacles as well as speed and accuracy.

In health matters we invite Barry Gilbert from the Working Trials Liaison Council and Dr Jacqueline Boyd, Chair of The Kennel Club Activities Health and Welfare Sub-Group, to report on the ongoing study investigating how obstacles affect dogs in working trials, a follow-up to the study that featured in the February 2022 Kennel Gazette, and we find out what prompted Angie and Neil Allan to start showing Australian Shepherds, from Old English Sheepdogs, that led to campaigning the highly successful and well-known Ch/Fin/World Ch Allmark Fifth Avenue JW, 'Tiffany', the Challenge Certificate breed and bitch record holder as we look back at the success of the Allmark kennel.

In our news pages we look ahead to World Mental Health Day on 10 October and that research from The Kennel Club shows that an overwhelming 97% of owners agree their dog improves their mental health, the Dandie Dinmont Terrier Club made history in July as it was commemorated with a special blue plaque on the outside of The Fleece in Selkirk unveiled by The Kennel Club Vice Chairman, Paul Eardley, winners of the International Canine Health Awards are revealed, events coming up celebrating the Irish Kennel Club's centenary and how you can book your ticket to The Kennel Club Health and Welfare Conference on 12 November at Chesford Grange, Kenilworth.

The Giant Schnauzer, a powerful all-round worker with great stamina and endurance is our breed of the month. We look back at its origins, how it turned



its talents to guarding work in the cities where it has also been used as a police dog and as a tracking dog. With its giant successes in obedience, search and rescue and agility it is a breed that enjoys many activities, despite its grand stature. The breed is generally tough and hardy and has few health problems, but the breed health coordinator advises what to look out for and where support can be found. We also look back at its accomplishments at Crufts - four time winner in the group to the ultimate accolade of Crufts Best in Show in 2008, and two breed-specialist judges choose their three favourite Giant Schnauzers that they have judged in the show ring in Judges' Choice.

Search is on for UK's hero dogs

The nationwide search has begun to find the UK's top dog who will be crowned the 2023 winner of The Kennel Club Hero Dog Award, which celebrates extraordinary unsung canine heroes and the remarkable ways that dogs transform our lives.

At Crufts 2022, Bob and a team of life-saving Newfoundlands, with their owner, Pete Lewin, were announced as the winners of The Kennel Club's prestigious award, presented by the competition's ambassador, actress Sally Phillips – who credits her own dogs for changing her family's life. Crowned as the UK's top hero dogs, Pete's Newfoundlands provide support for staff from front-line emergency services and military veterans, and those struggling with their mental health, through open-water swimming.

Pete has worked with water dogs as a hobby for around 25 years and both his own experiences and feedback from others about the positive effects of swimming in open water with Newfoundlands, who are natural water rescue dogs, made him realise the potential for a unique experience to support people with mental health needs.

Speaking about Bob and the team's recognition, Pete said: "I never expected all of this, I'm just a paramedic who helps people by swimming with my dogs. The work we do is for the emergency services staff, veterans, disabled children with different needs. Getting this award is just amazing - not just for me but the whole team - it's quite unique what these Newfoundlands do."

The Kennel Club is now searching for more inspirational stories and is calling for the public to nominate their unsung canine heroes who deserve to be recognised for what they do for The Kennel Club Hero Dog Award 2023.

The winner of the award, which is supported by The Kennel Club Charitable Trust, will be revealed at Crufts 2023 on

Sunday 12 March, and will be awarded £5,000 for a dog charity of their choice. Runners up will receive £1,000 for their chosen dog charity.

Nominations for four-legged heroes can be made within the following categories:

EXTRAORDINARY LIFE OF A WORKING DOG – For those who have shown extraordinary qualities working in the army, police force, RAF, airport, search and rescue etc.

HERO SUPPORT DOG – Celebrating all support and assistance dogs, from medical detection dogs or hearing dogs, to therapy dogs or pets who provide emotional support.

BEST FRIENDS – Celebrating a canine companion who has seen its owner through the hardest times, as well as the happiest.

CHILD'S CHAMPION – Recognising a dog that has supported and had a positive impact on a child's life (16 years and under).

RESCUE DOG HERO – for a rescue dog who has overcome adversity and gone on to irrevocably improve the life of their owner/s.

The nominations are open until 2 October 2022 and five finalists will be chosen to go forward to the final at Crufts 2023, where the overall winner, selected by public vote, will be announced before the grand finale of the Crufts Best in Show award on 12 March.



Vanessa McAlpine, Crufts Show Manager commented: "We are very much looking forward to holding The Kennel Club Hero Dog Award competition at Crufts in 2023. Every day there are brave dogs out there protecting the public, giving confidence and independence to those with disabilities – both mental and physical – and showing remarkable loyalty as our companions, and this award showcases all that our four-legged heroes do for us and in society.

"We want to hear from anybody who has a heart-warming tale about how their dog has changed their life, how a canine companion has made a difference for a friend or family member, or about those heroic dogs who work to keep us safe. The winner will take centre stage at Crufts 2023, an event which is dedicated to celebrating the diverse role that dogs play in society and all the ways that they enrich our lives.

"We encourage anybody who knows of a four-legged hero to put them forward for recognition in this competition and showcase all the reasons why dogs are known as 'man's best friend'."

Nominations can be made by visiting crufts.org.uk/herodogaward. Finalists will be announced next year, ahead of the winner being crowned Crufts 2023, taking place at the NEC in Birmingham from 9-12 March 2023.

Kennel Club strategic direction – A time for sharing

Clearly this is a strange time for the Kennel Club. On one hand we feel the immense sadness that our Patron, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II is no longer with us. The end of an era for The Kennel Club and its staff and members. On the other hand it's the start of something that we believe she would have approved of. Safeguarding our heritage, ensuring continuity but also moving with the time to keep us recognised, respected and relevant. On 13th September The Kennel Club Board agreed a new strategic direction which will drive our focus for the next ten years. We can now begin the process of sharing our direction with members, staff and stakeholders, and start working together to agree how we can deliver the changes and improvements set out in the strategic direction.

And start to share we have! On 22nd September staff were introduced to the new strategic direction, its six key strategic aims and the projects that sit beneath. Tony Allcock, Chairman and Paul Eardley, Vice-Chair and Mark Beazley, Chief Executive all were clear that the intent of the direction is a pointer to the future. How we'll deliver on each of these strategic aims, and when they will become a reality is now down to the experts to design with the end users in mind. We'll bring in the general dog owning public, and we'll involve our clubs, societies and volunteers. We'll draw upon experts across our stakeholder groups including Staff, Board Directors, Members, Committees, the Dog Press and external stakeholders. Together they will help frame what the future will look like in order to help us develop the plans to improve how The KC works over the next decade.

The first member roadshow had just been held as we went to press – in Stockport on Tuesday 27th September at

Bredbury Hall Hotel. At a small, personal round table event members and Florence – an Italian Greyhound, attended the first roadshow that we have been able to hold due to pandemics etc for the last four years.

Paul Eardley, Vice-Chair opened by sharing the journey The Kennel Club has been on for the past few years, and went on to outline the road ahead, followed by a message from Tony Allcock, Chairman sharing his passion for The Kennel Club and promising to keep members informed and involved as we travel on down that road.

A short animated film shared the six strategic aims and the activities that will help to make them possible. Most importantly, demonstrating how inter-related these enabling activities are and therefore how some challenges need to be resolved first before we can deliver on other areas.

Then it was time for questions and conversation; about the strategy, the strategic aims and wider concerns about the impact that the cost of living is having on our dog community. Mark Beazley, Chief Executive summed up the evening and shared the key themes of the conversations he had heard throughout the night. He talked about what happens next; not least the further five live roadshows between now and the end of November (see the website for more details), and the two virtual events for those members who prefer not to travel.

He also shared an outline of further upcoming research involving clubs, societies and participants in canine events. The Governance and Organisational Development project is ongoing and a diverse group of representatives from each of The Kennel Club's stakeholder groups (Board Director, Committees, Member, Our Dogs,

Executive Team, and Staff) has been formed to be a 'sounding board' for this important project. This group will help shape our new ways of working to ensure we are quicker, more agile and decisive so we can better deliver our strategic direction. He also spoke about how we'll keep members informed of our strategy progress via social media, the website, Chairman's updates and of course more events such as this. Summing up Mark said, "There's a lot to do. But the future is looking forward not back. Fixing what needs to be fixed, and carving out a better space for The Kennel Club as soon as we can."

After the event, the members fed back that they liked the informality of the small group and that this had probably encouraged people to speak who might not have normally. Shorter presentations allowed more time for discussion which was appreciated and they also felt that their opinions had been listened to. Said Keeley Newman-Jones, one of the attendees, "It's good to see the positivity of this new direction, not because what was there before wasn't right, but the world has moved on and so must The Kennel Club!"

A final word from Paul Eardley: "Stockport's roadshow was a great start to our roadshow lineup. Getting out to talk to our members, and hearing their views about the work that has been done to get us to this place, is key. We're looking forward to the next ones."

All in all a successful evening – with a clear direction forward for The Kennel Club. We hope Her Majesty would have approved.

BREED STANDARD AMENDMENTS

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendments to breed standards:

BELGIAN SHEPHERD DOG

General Appearance Medium-sized dog of harmonious proportions. Well-muscled and toned, combining elegance and strength without exaggeration. Attentive, hardy and alert. [Four varieties: Groenendael; Laekenois, Malinois and Tervueren to be judged to the same standard only differentiated by coat colour, texture and length.]

Characteristics Proud head carriage, watchful, attentive attitude, conveying an impression of graceful strength and intelligence. An agile, active and versatile dog whose primary purpose is herder and guardian of the flock.

Temperament Intelligent, alert and naturally vigilant. Devoted to his owners, may show some initial reserve, but not nervous or aggressive.

Head and Skull Head long without exaggeration. Skull and muzzle roughly equal in length, with, at most, slight bias in favour of muzzle, giving impression of balance. Skull of medium width in proportion to length of head. Centre line of skull not very pronounced. Head planes parallel with both forehead and upper line of muzzle flat. In profile an imaginary line extending the forehead would run parallel to the muzzle line. Muzzle tapering gradually to the nose but not snipy. Underjaw sufficiently developed. Head well chiselled beneath the eyes. Moderate stop and arches above eyes not prominent. Cheeks lean,

quite flat but well-muscled, and zygomatic arches not prominent. Nose black with well open nostrils.

Eyes Medium size, neither protruding nor sunken, slightly almond shaped and obliquely set, brown in colour, preferably dark brown, black rimmed eyelids. Direct, lively and enquiring expression.

Ears Distinctly triangular appearance, stiff and erect, set high and carried upright and vertical when dog is alert. Moderate length with external ear well rounded at base.

Mouth Lips thin, firm and tight with strong dark pigmentation. Strong white teeth firmly set in well-developed jaws. Scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws. Pincer [level] bite tolerated.

Neck Neck of moderate length, slightly arched giving a noble head carriage, well-muscled and without dewlap, broadening slightly towards shoulders.

Forequarters Withers distinct. Strong, but not heavy bone throughout with wiry, powerful muscle structure. Shoulder blades flat, long and oblique, firmly attached, moderately angulated, with long upper arm. Elbows firm, neither loose nor tied in. Forelegs long, well-muscled, parallel. Pasterns strong, short, perpendicular to ground or very slightly inclined. Dewclaws permissible.

Body Body square, powerful but elegant. Length from point of shoulders to point of buttocks approximately equal to height at withers. Chest deep and well let down to point of elbow in the mature dog. Ribs moderately well-sprung. Back short with upper line of body straight, firm and well-muscled. Belly moderately developed neither drooping nor unduly cut up continuing lower line of chest in a graceful curve. Loin short, sufficiently broad and well-muscled. Croup very slightly sloping, sufficiently broad but not excessively so. Skin springy but quite taut over whole body.

Hindquarters Well-muscled and powerful. Moderate, not excessive angulation; hocks well let down. Viewed from behind, legs parallel.

Feet Toes arched, very close together; soles thick and springy with dark, strong nails. Forefeet round and cat-like. Hindfeet slightly oval.

Gait/Movement Brisk, light, economic action, covering ground without over extension or exaggeration, consistent with their moderate angulation, topline remaining firm. Single tracks at speed.

Coat There are three distinct coat types.

Groenendael/Tervueren - Outer coat long, straight and abundant, texture of medium harshness. Not silky or wiry. Undercoat extremely dense. Hair short on head, outside of ears and lower part of legs. Opening of ear protected by hair. Hair especially long and abundant, ruff-like around neck, particularly in males. Fringe of long hair down back of forelegs, long and abundant hair evident on hindquarters and tail. Males heavier coated than females.

Laekenois - Harsh, wiry, dry, and not curly. Fluffy, fine hair is undesirable. Length of coat about 6cms (2½ins) on all parts of body. The hair is shorter on the top of the muzzle, the forehead and the legs. Furnishings on the sides and underside of the

muzzle and hair around the eyes, but should not be so long as to disguise the shape of the head, obscure the eyes, or make the head appear square or heavy. Tail not plumed.

Malinois - Hair very short on head, exterior of ears and lower parts of legs. Short on rest of body, thicker on tail and around neck where it resembles a ridge or collar, beginning at base of ear and extending to throat. Hindquarters fringed with longer hair. Thicker hair on tail but not plumed. Coat thick, close of good firm texture with woolly undercoat, neither silky nor wiry.

No variation in these types is acceptable.

Colour The acceptable colours relate directly to coat type.

Groenendael - Black. Frosting (white or grey) on the muzzle is a normal occurrence in the breed.

Laekenois - Reddish fawn with black shading, principally in muzzle and tail.

Tervueren/Malinois - All shades of red, fawn, grey, with black overlay. Coat characteristically double pigmented where tips of light coloured hairs are blackened. On mature males this blackening is especially pronounced on shoulders, back and rib sections. However this overlay should not form solid areas of black but should be seen as a light dusting. Equally it should be noted that overlay develops with age and should not be expected to be clearly evident on younger animals. Beyond the age of 18 months a washed-out colour or colour too black undesirable. Black mask on face not extending above the eye and brow area, ears mostly black. Tail should have a darker or black tip. Frosting (white or grey) on the muzzle is a normal occurrence in the breed.

For all varieties a small amount of white is tolerated on forechest and toes.

No variation on these colours by coat type is acceptable.

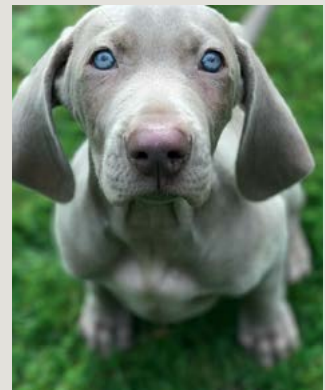

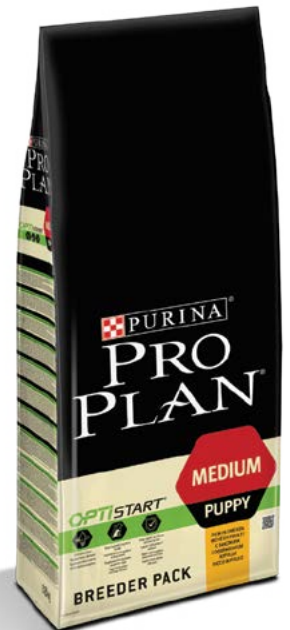
